# **Easy Water Heater Odor-Killer Kit**

The Rusco Hot Water Spin Down Filter, 3/4" Pipe Size, 60 Mesh

The Rusco Hot Water Spin Down filter is ideally suited to be used as a pre-filter assembly installed on the cold-water line inlet to the water heater. This is a convenient way to add hydrogen peroxide or chlorine bleach into the system, instantly sanitizing and eliminating sulfur odors in the water heater. Unlike regular plastic pre-filters, the Rusco Hot Water Filter is chemically resistant and not affected by higher temperatures.

## Kit includes:

- Rusco Hot Water Filter (60 mesh 3/4"NPT thread)
- 2. Stainless steel filter screen
- 3. Easy flushing valve for clearing out sediment buildup.
- 4. Optional ¾ Stainless Steel nipple installation kit.

#### How it works:


- Simply turn water off and add one pint of standard 3% hydrogen peroxide (Easily purchased at local drugstore) to sump of the Odor Killer Filter.
- 2. Turn water back on. Open hot faucet or tap in home and run water for several minutes.
- 3. Let peroxide sit in water heater for 3 to 4 hours.
- 4. Open hot water tap or faucet in home and run water for 10 minutes.
- 5. Odors are gone!
- 6. Kills bacteria, eliminates odors, and stops slime build-up.
- 7. Safe, non-toxic peroxide breaks down into oxygen and water after killing odors.



# **How to Install Water Heater Odor-Killer Filter Housing**

(Note: The Inlet and Outlet ports of the filter assembly are female ¾" NPT. When installing fittings into these ports we recommend using 2-4 wraps of Teflon tape and a thread sealant on the threads to ensure there are no water leaks.

- Shut off water supply and vent pressure. Install the Odor Killer filter into the cold-water inlet line to the water heater as shown in the diagram.
- 2. Turn water pressure back on and leak check to verify installation was successful.

### How to Use Your Water Heater Odor Killer

- 1. Shut off water supply and vent pressure by opening a hot water faucet in the house.
- 2. Unscrew the bottom sump on the water odor filter and add 1 pint of hydrogen peroxide or chlorine solution to the bottom sump.
- 3. Carefully re-install and thread the sump back onto the filter housing hand tight.
- 4. Turn water supply on, open hot water faucet, and flow water into the water heater for 3-4 minutes.
- 5. Close hot water faucet and allow water solution to sit in the water heater for 3-4 hours.
- 6. Open hot water faucet and allow water to flow for several minutes. (Note, if you are using chlorine, you may want to run for a longer time to allow all of the chlorine solution to rinse out of the water heater).
- 7. Repeat Steps 1-6 if odor returns (between 2 weeks and several months depending on water chemistry).
